CIE offers a wide range of academic and vocational qualifications in more than 150 countries. Cambridge AICE is an international pre-university curriculum and examination system, which emphasizes the value of broad and balanced study for academically able students. Its strengths lie in the flexibility and structure of the curriculum, encouraging in-depth, working knowledge of each subject, and essay-based examinations as assessment of that knowledge and skill mastery.



Innovative

Cambridge AICE courses are equivalent to US university freshman-level courses or higher. Routes to the Cambridge AICE Diploma are extremely flexible and offer students the opportunity to tailor their studies to their individual interests, abilities, and future plans within an international curriculum framework.

High School Focus: Grades 9-12

FLVS Full Time High School is proud to provide multiple options for academically dedicated students including Dual Enrollment, Advanced Placement®* (AP®), and now AICE courses. Flexibility in choosing these courses will allow students to pursue areas of special interest while meeting requirements for university entrance.



Application Criteria

- Only incoming 9th and 10th grade students may apply.
- Students applying must have an overall GPA of 2.5 or higher in the previous school year. Students must also be in good academic standing for the previous school year (pace, progress, attendance, and communication with teachers). Student conduct through the previous school year should be exemplary.
- Returning students are expected to maintain a 2.5 GPA or higher, maintain good academic standing, and exemplify outstanding conduct throughout the duration of their participation in the program.
- At the end of each school year, we will conduct a program review of all current students. If the student's academic or conduct record no longer meets the admission requirements, the student's acceptance will be revoked.

Tailored International Curriculum

The AICE program and curriculum is overseen by the University of Cambridge, an institution consistently ranked as one of the top five academic universities in the world. It is a flexible, broad-based, two-year curriculum, which is offered worldwide at schools and colleges in more than 150 countries. For more than 170 years the prestigious University of Cambridge has been setting worldwide curriculum standards through their examinations.

American universities have responded enthusiastically to AICE. The Florida Legislature has identified AICE as a graduation option and acceleration mechanism through which high school students can be awarded college credit. Students earning the AICE Diploma qualify for the maximum Florida Bright Futures tuition scholarship and students completing the curriculum can earn the Florida Medallion Scholars Tuition Award.

Students who complete the AICE curriculum will be provided the best possible foundation for advanced post-secondary studies anywhere in the world. FLVS Full Time High School is proud to offer the AICE program in the United States.
