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FLVS FULL TIME PUBLIC SCHOOL (Full Time Enrollment)

ENROLLMENT OPTION	Take all courses through FLVS Full Time exclusively. Student is not enrolled in a traditional school or registered as a homeschool student
SCHOOL OF RECORD	FLVS Full Time counselor advises student on course progression plan, manages transcript, and the school issues official report cards
ENROLLMENT WINDOW	Twice per year, prior to fall or spring semesters
COURSE LOAD	6 courses per semester
SCHOOL SCHEDULE	Daily attendance required, August-May
LIVE LESSONS	Required for grades K-5 and strongly encouraged for grades 6-12
STATE TESTING	State standardized exams required
DIPLOMA	State of Florida diploma issued by FLVS Full Time

	Take individual courses through FLVS Flex, either in addition to courses at a traditional school or as part of a homeschool education
Traditional School Student	Traditional school counselor guides course progression plan. The school manages transcripts and issues official report cards.
Home Education Student	Homeschool parent/guardian guides course progression plan, manages the student's portfolio, and approves courses

Home Education Student	Up to 6 courses concurrently to supplement course load
