**Mike Miller** is the Chief External Affairs Officer for Florida Virtual School® (FLVS®). In addition to managing educational advocacy, he oversees the Financial & Treasury Services and Procurement Departments. He plays a vital role in lobbying for fair access to education as well as guiding financial services for the organization.

Mr. Miller has a long career in public service, spanning nearly 30 years. Before joining FLVS in 2019, he was a State Representative for the Florida House of Representatives and worked with local leaders in both parties on issues to better the community. He has served on various committees for Commerce and K-12 education, as well as health quality committees such as advocating for victims of crimes or trauma, affordable housing for seniors and families, and homeless youth.

He currently serves on the boards of Goodwill Industries of Central Florida, the North and Central Florida Chapter of the Alzheimer's Association, AMI Kids Orlando (an afterschool program for at-risk kids), and the Florida Network (a statewide association representing 29 agencies that serve homeless, runaway, and troubled youths and their families).
