Kindergarten-Grade 2

Primary students will learn to read and will be given a strong foundation in phonemic awareness and phonics. Students will learn spelling and grammar skills that will support them as they participate in creating informative, narrative, and opinion writing compositions throughout the course.

Grades 3-5

Intermediate students will focus on reading to learn with the incorporation of more complex text and extensive exploration and use of vocabulary in reading and writing. Students will be taught grammar skills which will be implemented into the rigorous writing lessons and complement various topics. Students will participate in informative, narrative, and opinion writing compositions throughout the course.
