



Graduation Rate Climbs to All-Time High

Florida Virtual High School (FVHS) achieved a 97% graduation rate for the 2024–25 academic year, the highest in the school's history. FVHS now has the fourth-highest high school graduation rate in the state (excluding lab schools, which are public K-12 schools affiliated with state universities).
