Students will be exposed to character education requirements through career and college planning tools. Students may also meet the Character Education requirement by taking either Career Research and Decision Making or Digital Information Technology.

Although world language credits are not required for graduation, 2 credits in the same world language are needed for Bright Futures and State University System (SUS) admission. These 2 credits can be incorporated into the 18 credit ACCEL option as 2 out of the three elective credits needed.

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
