

## Florida Virtual High School Parents' Right-to-Know Accountability and Report Cards August 18<sup>th</sup>, 2025

Dear Parent or Guardian:

You have the right to know about your child's academic progress toward college and career readiness. Your child regularly receives academic progress reports and report cards through their school, including information on state assessments in reading, English/language arts, and mathematics. These results can be found in the student's FOCUS portal. Directions on how to access your student's assessment results can be found here.

The district must provide you with information on each state and locally required assessment consistent with Title I under the Every Student Succeeds Act, Pub L. No 114-95. Such information must include the subject matter, purpose, and source of the assessments. It may include time expected and scheduled for the assessments and times and formats for disseminating assessment results.

The district administers FAST testing three times a year in Reading/ELA for Kindergarten through grade 10, Mathematics for Kindergarten through grade 8, and writing for grades 4 through 10. Specific courses also require an End of Course (EOC) exam.
